## MORGAN FIELDS/WEST COBB TH to CHERRY BEND TH (HWY 23)

The area highlighted in blue is gravel and much shorter but may not be open yet. If it is follow it across until you hit hwy 23 and take a left. Aid station is just down the highway a bit on the left after the curve. I suggest the longer way.
The longer way, you head back down towards Redding. Once you are back at hwy 215, take a right and follow it until it runs into hwy 23 . Take a right onto hwy 23 for 5 miles. TH/aid is on the right. LIMITED PARKING HERE!


## CHERRY BEND to BLACK MOUNTAIN

Head south from Cherry Bend on hwy 23 for 6.4 miles then turn right onto White Rock Mountain Rd. for about 5.6 miles (a right just after crossing a little bridge past Cass Job Corps). Turn right onto Ragtown Rd. for about 0.8 miles.
Make sure you do not take a left at any " Y " or " $T$ " in the road. Where you turn right onto Ragtown Rd., after Gray's Spring, the road to White Rock that goes left here, is closed. Hopefully next year this will be open again to make getting to Shores Lake and White Rock much easier. To get to Shores Lake, you will come right back down this way to hit 23 hwy again.


## BLACK MOUNTAIN to SHORES LAKE

Leave Black Mountain exactly the way you came up. Point 0.8 on Ragtown Rd. then take a left onto White Rock Mountain Rd. and drive the 5.6 back to hwy 23. Take a right onto hwy 23 and drive a short distance, about 0.4 miles, to Shores Lake Rd. Three images are below to help with navigation.
